

2014 Soccer Hall of Fame Inductees



GEORGE KUHN



When soccer needed a leader, Kuhn provided direction. The lifelong Frederick County resident served as varsity head coach from 1962 until 1995, first at Emmitsburg, then at Catoctin high schools. He was the longest tenured high school sports coach in any sport in Frederick County history when he resigned in 1995. Kuhn coached one state runner-up team (Catoctin, 1973) and seven district champions. He made his mark in leadership roles, serving as District I chairman for 10 years and state soccer chairman for 15 years. He organized the first youth soccer clinic in Frederick County, held at Middletown High, where 750 youths

attended the event that featured Navy's men's soccer team. He was the first president of the Frederick County Coaches Association. He also was a charter member of the Blue Ridge Soccer Officials Association and became a collegiate soccer official, where he worked NCAA Division I matches.


PETER MEDD



Medd excelled at every level of soccer. He was a six-time Maryland ODP selection who played club soccer for a five-time State Cup-winning program. In high school, Medd played four years of varsity soccer as Middletown went 48-4-3 during that time, never losing to a Frederick County team. He guided Middletown, where he was a four-time all-league and all-area pick, to a state title in 1993. He was a four-year starter at Towson and earned all-conference and all-region honors. Medd was the first-round pro pick of the Baltimore Blast in 1998 and played three seasons. He coached on the club, college and professional levels. He served as president of Crystal

Palace FC USA from 2006-10, where he was recognized as Division 3 Professional Executive of the Year in 2008. He was a founding member of the new NASL.


JOHN MILLER



When the torch was passed from John Horine to John Miller, it was Miller who took the already successful Middletown girls soccer program to unparalleled heights. Middletown went 203-42-5 during Miller's coaching reign from 1987 through 2002. The program won three state titles and rolled off 13 straight MVAL titles from 1988 (the first year of the girls soccer league) through 2000. His program added a 14th MVAL crown in 2002. Miller was a two-time state coach of the year and the 1996 NSCAA National Coach of the Year. Middletown became the county's first girls soccer state champion in 1990 and first back-to-back soccer state champions with titles in

1999 and 2000. Miller coached 14 all-state players, many of whom went on to NCAA college soccer careers.

CHUCK NICHOLS



Nichols has had a storied career as a player and coach. In fact, he's one of a handful of coaches who have the distinction of winning high school state titles in Maryland as a player (Middletown boys, 1973) and as a head coach (Thomas Johnson girls, 1997, 2001; Urbana girls, 2007). As a three-year varsity player at Middletown, he helped the Knights to a state title (1973), a state runner-up finish (1974) and a district runner-up finish (1972). He was also part of the inaugural Maryland high school all-state team in 1974. At Pfeiffer College, he was a four-time all-conference player who helped the program to two district titles and one district runner-up finish. As a high school head

coach for TJ boys and girls and Urbana girls, he has nine region titles to go with three state titles.
